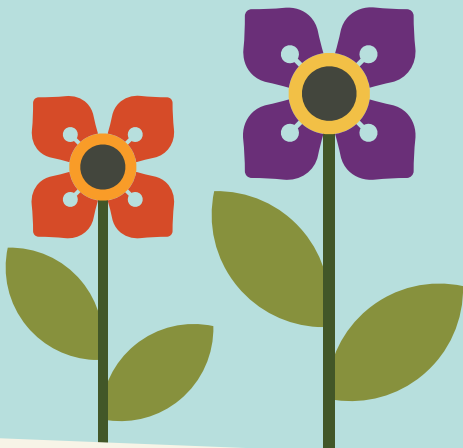

Gallons of water refilled at the store: 180,637 gallons



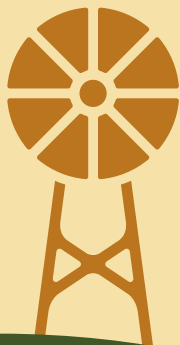
LOCAL IMPACT
